

REGULATIONS FOR THE CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS WITH DHL EXPRESS DOMESTIC

Part 3: DHL Express national

1. General information / Scope of application

Part 3 of the Regulations for the Carriage of Dangerous Goods applies for:

DHL DOMESTIC EXPRESS 9:00
DHL DOMESTIC EXPRESS 10:30
DHL MEDICAL EXPRESS DOMESTIC

DHL DOMESTIC EXPRESS 12:00
DHL DOMESTIC EXPRESS

The following designations and classifications correspond with the Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road” (ADR)

Unless otherwise specified, the following statutes apply:

- The German Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act (Gesetz über die Beförderung gefährlicher Güter – GGBefG),
- The German “Dangerous Goods Ordinance for Road, Rail, and Inland Waterways” (Gefahrgutverordnung Straße, Eisenbahn und Binnenschifffahrt – GGVSEB)

The Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road” (ADR)

2. Permissible substances and articles

- DHL accepts hazardous substances and items for national express shipment if their carriage is subject to exemption under the provisions of ADR chapters 1.1.3.4 and 1.1.3.9.
- This applies to exemptions related to special provisions under chapter 3.3, to dangerous goods that are transported in combination packaging pursuant to chapter 3.4 (limited quantities) and chapter 3.5 (excepted quantities), and to dangerous goods that are used as coolant or conditioning agent during carriage.
- Dangerous goods listed in chapter 3.2., dangerous goods list, table A, column 7a with a value of “0”, or column 7b with an “E0” code, are generally not accepted by DHL Express as limited or exempted quantities for transport.
- Shipping of biological substances category B, UN3373 class 6.2 is only permitted by means of the DHL Medical Express Domestic product. The requirement for this is the application of ADR packaging instruction P650.
- UN numbers of dangerous goods assigned to (Sub-) classes 1; 2.3; 6.2 (with the exception of UN3373) and 7 are generally excluded from shipping.
- High consequence dangerous goods according to ADR Chapter 1.10.3. are generally

excluded from shipping

Special notes

- The transport of dangerous goods with obligation of labelling is a service with costs (see dhl-express-products-services-prices) and only possible by means of a shipment logistics system (SLS) that uses electronic data transmission; the use of manual waybills is prohibited.
- If the service is not selected by the customer in the SLS, DHL reserves the right to use the dangerous goods declaration to record and treat the shipment as a dangerous goods shipment against calculation of the corresponding surcharge.
- The shipping of more than 25kg of dry ice, UN 1057 lighters, refill cartridges, or more than 2 cryogenic containers with liquid nitrogen must be announced in advance per pickup.
- If necessary, DHL Express reserves the right to apply §§HGB 410 and 414 in connection with dangerous goods.

Delivery options:

- Shipments containing hazardous goods with obligation of labelling must not be addressed to a DHL Packstation (with the exception of lithium batteries in accordance with ADR special regulation 188).
- The service "Signature Release" (delivery without signature) is also not available (except for lithium batteries in accordance with ADR special regulation 188).
- On-demand delivery options "Pickup at a DHL Express Service Point" and "Vacation Hold" can also not be selected for dangerous goods shipments (except for lithium batteries according to ADR special regulation 188).
